

ABOUT LMTAAA

The Lewis-Mason-Thurston Area Agency on Aging (LMTAAA) was created through the Older Americans Act and has operated under the sponsorship of Lewis, Mason and Thurston Counties since 1976. The policy board of the Agency is the Council of Governments (COG), which is made up of one county commissioner from each of the three sponsoring counties.

LMTAAA staff directly provides a variety of services that support individuals, families, and caregivers. We provide case management and nurse consultation for approximately 6,000 individuals receiving Medicaid paid in-home care assistance. Our ADRC program receives more than 13,000 calls a year from individuals requesting information about how to access local services and support.

LMTAAA staff also works with community organizations in developing, monitoring and managing the delivery of services to seniors and disabled adults. LMTAAA contracts with governmental and non-governmental agencies for the delivery of a wide variety of services to eligible individuals. Services provided through contracts include: nutrition services, adult day care, transportation, legal assistance, respite care, in-home personal care, kinship and family caregiver support, and a multitude of Medicaid waiver services.

Our team is composed of highly dedicated and experienced people who value service, excellence, empowerment and collaboration.

HOW TO USE THIS DIRECTORY

In the Lewis-Mason-Thurston Area Agency on Aging (LMTAAA) Resource Directory you will find a wide range of services that are available to help those who find it difficult to maintain their independence. Some of the reasons for this difficulty can be related to chronic illnesses or other health-related problems, surgeries, accidents, or the gradual loss of capabilities associated with the natural aging process. Our emphasis is on providing services that allow a person to remain in the least restrictive environment possible.

Every attempt has been made to ensure that this publication is current, with a focus on public and nonprofit services. The information in this directory is provided as a starting point, and as an encouragement to the residents of Lewis, Mason, and Thurston Counties to seek assistance when needed. CARE/CASE MANAGEMENT

PRIVATE CARE MANAGERS

Private care managers provide consultations to people and their families, who are living at home and experiencing difficulties managing daily activities due to illness or disability. Care managers can help develop a plan of care, or arrange for services, such as caregivers, guardians, appropriate housing, or legal assistance. Care managers who are nurses can also provide medical evaluations and manage medical care. Other care managers have Master's degrees in Gerontology, Social Work, Nursing or Counseling. Expect to pay \$90 - \$175 per hour for care management services.

GUARDIANSHIP SERVICES

Guardianship is a legal option that is available when a person has significant problems that prevent them from managing their financial affairs or caring for themselves. Guardianships are granted when a court proceeding determines that a person is legally incapacitated. Because guardianship deprives an individual of significant personal rights, it is considered a last resort, after all other options have been considered.

MEDICATION DISPOSAL SITES

Today, medicine cabinets are full of unwanted or expired medications. Many of these medications, if mismanaged, pose serious safety and environmental threats ranging from child poisoning or illegal use to contamination of our waterways and drinking water.

Placing medicines in the trash, sink drains, or flushing them down the toilet may seem like the easy answer, but medicine in unsecured trash bins can be stolen and wastewater treatment plants do not effectively remove these drugs from our water supply. As a result, measurable amounts of drugs end up in our water supply.

Perhaps most importantly, getting rid of unused medicines in a safe manner will help reduce access to drugs that could be abused. So what should you do with those old medications? Fortunately, there are several good options for safely disposing of old or excess medications locally. Location information can be found below:

PALLIATIVE CARE

The goal of palliative care is to help patients with serious illnesses feel better. It prevents or treats symptoms and side effects of disease and treatment. Palliative care also treats emotional, social, practical, and spiritual problems that illnesses can bring up. When patients feel better in these areas, they have an improved quality of life.

Palliative care can be given at the same time as treatments meant to cure or treat the disease. You may get palliative care when the illness is diagnosed, throughout treatment, during follow-up, and at the end of life.

Palliative care may be offered for people with illnesses, such as: cancer, heart disease, lung diseases, kidney failure and dementia. You do not need to give up your doctor or your treatments to receive palliative care.



RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITIES

INTRODUCTION

When people are no longer able to care for themselves in their own homes, a move, either temporary or permanent, may be necessary. There are many long-term care options available depending upon what type of care is needed. Residential care includes retirement residences, adult family homes, assisted living/boarding home facilities, and skilled nursing facilities.

Adult Family Homes are regular neighborhood homes where staff assumes responsibility for the safety and well-being of the adult. Some may also provide occasional nursing care.

AFH Facility Search (wa.gov)

Assisted Living Facilities are larger facilities in a community setting where staff assumes responsibility for the safety and well-being of the adult. Some Assisted Living Facilities also provide nursing care.

ALF Facility Search (wa.gov)

Skilled Nursing Facilities provide 24-hour supervised nursing care, personal care, therapy, nutrition management, organized activities, social services, room, board and laundry.
